Work on the LA Metro Regional Connector Transit Corridor Project

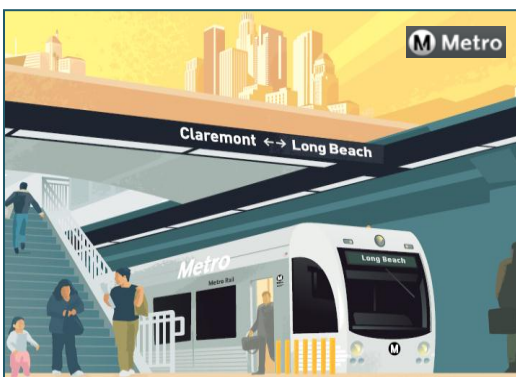
The Regional Connector Constructors Joint Venture is currently recruiting construction workers for the **federally funded five year** Regional Connector Transit Corridor project. This 1.9 mile underground rail construction project will extend from Little Tokyo/Arts District Station to the 7th St. Metro Center in downtown Los Angeles.

The project is subject to a PLA requiring apprentices, workers from Targeted Zip Codes, and “Disadvantaged” workers who face barriers to employment.

Disadvantaged workers must meet **two or more** of the following criteria:

- Homeless
- Custodial Single Parent
- Receiving Public Assistance
- Do not have High School Diploma or GED
- Criminal Justice Record
- Unemployed for at least last 27 weeks
- Veteran of Iraq or Afghanistan
- Apprentice with less than 15% of Journeyman hours
